ADMISSIONS REQUIREMENTS

- 1) Completion of an Associate in Arts degree or higher or a minimum of 60 credits from a regionally accredited institution, including all General Education requirements per St. Petersburg College requirements.
- 2) Completion of state-mandated prerequisite with a grade of C or higher:
 - EDF 1005 Introduction to Education.
 - MAC 2311 Calculus & Analytic Geometry
 - MAC XXXX (4 credits of additional mathematics coursework with "MAC" prefix)
- 3) A cumulative GPA of 2.50 or higher (on a 4.00 scale).
