ABOUT THE PROGRAM

As additional elementary schools are enrolling children as early as three years of age, more skilled teachers are required that understand how to meet the developmental needs of young children. This degree prepares students to teach ages 3 through grade 3 and allows graduates to earn teacher certification in PreK/Primary as well as endorsements in ESOL (English to Speakers of Other Languages) and Reading.

ADMISSIONS REQUIREMENTS

- 1) Completion of an Associate in Arts degree and a minimum of 60 credits from a regionally accredited institution, including all General Education requirements per St. Petersburg College requirements.**
- 2) Completion of state-mandated prerequisite with a grade of C or higher:
 - EDF 1005 Introduction to Education.
- 3) A cumulative GPA of 2.50 or higher (on a 4.00 scale).

Important General Knowledge Test Information

The **General Knowledge Test** must be completed within the first semester of the program. Completion of all four sections of the General Knowledge test will be required within the first semester of coursework for students to continue in this degree plan.
