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Current Business:

JWB continues to fund scholarships for students in the A.S. Early Childhood degree and the B.S. EDST Early Childhood Education degree. New funds were received in May, 2020 Applications for Fall scholarships are open – deadline is June 15th

TEACH continues to support ECE students at all levels

Early Child Development Certificate (CHDEV-CT) is a 36 credit Certificate that meets the FL OEL Tier III requirement. It is also Financial Aid eligible.

Working with City of St Petersburg re: Infant Toddler Specialization Certificate (ITSP) and Preschool Specialization Certificate (PRSP) Certificates focused on providing tuition for childcare providers in specific zip codes

Decisions about January 2021 conference to be held on the Clearwater Campus are pending.

FLAEYC Conference in October moving forward at this time with possible change to 'virtual presentations'

Enrollment continues to grow for Fall 2020. At this time all courses will be online with a possible 'live online' for Spring

Changes to A.S. program and Articulation for 2020-21 academic year. The program will reduce the Electives to three credits which will allow EEC 1512, Caring for Infants and Toddlers to be in the Major Core. This will change the Articulation agreement and students who apply will continue to receive 9 credits: EEC 2312, EEC 1308 and three, EDG 1319. The changes will be presented at the next PCS Joint Advisory Meeting.

Program Updates and Community Sharing:

Child Care Wages – the name has changed to Child Care Incentives. ELC bringing program in house to eliminate some of the fees. Want to expand the area served as right now open to small number of zip codes. Expand to more of Pinellas County.

Gino Cote' said everything is fluid right now as far as opening the Center, week to week planning.

MaryAnn Goodrich mentioned ELC has no clear direction on processes yet and it is challenging. No Readiness rate for next year, not a requirement and those on probation that didn't meet will still need to complete and improvement plan for staff development or curriculum and an area of focus. Trainings are online and assessment at the end. Email her for calendar. VPKLearningCircles@oel.myflorida.com No direction for summer VPK, no decision made yet.

Gail Ramsdell – It is a different time. Plans must be flexible. Ready Set Kindergarten Adventures has daily lessons for all on the PCS website. Most projects on hold. One of the books, 'Fox Makes a Friend' will be used and they are working on a video that is read aloud and interactive. Also working on a registration video for kindergarten.



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Susan Weber – R' Club moving forward slowly due to unknown. 7 centers closed and others running at at lower capacity. R'Club kept all their staff. Lew Williams open will be opening soon. Looking for ideas for professional training and internship ideas.

Maria Climes – trying to increase hiring and recruitment at R' Club.

Carol Dinsdale – listening to info coming in. Trying to keep parents and children feeling safe and loved while this is going on and making things as normal as possible.

Anne Ryan responded that consistency in environment is a key piece within your control. Answer questions as best you can and openly address as best you can. Don't shut down the conversations.

Susan Weber – discussed mixing age groups is reality right now and teachers understand.

Debra Barker – DCF extended 12-month training with limited exam sessions.
