1 credit hour = 60 contact hours; 2 credit hours = 120 contact hours; 3 credit hours = 180 contact hours

The 1 credit option can be a shadowing experience or work in a biology-related field

The 2 credit option must be work in a biology-related field

The 3 credit option must be work in a biology-related field that is centered around a project. The student will submit a written report of the project.

Before you are enrolled in the internship course, you must meet the following requirements:

- □ Enrollment in BS Biology program as a degree-seeking student
- □ Complete at least 15 credit hours of upper-division Biology courses
- Complete the Internship Application before the application deadline.
- \Box Secure an internship related to your major
- Submit internship placement details using this form.
