## Priority deadline dates

- SPC's FAFSA priority deadline date for financial aid packaging ..... Oct. 1
  - Priority deadline date for admissions applications and materials (i.e. transcripts) for Regular classes ..... Dec. 1
- You may still enroll in regular classes if the application is received after this date; however, there is no guarantee transcripts will be evaluated prior to the beginning of Full Term.*

## Tuition due dates

- Universal due date for Winter Session, Full Term, Weekend College and First 8 Week Session for enrollment between Oct. 21 and Dec. 4 ..... Dec. 4
- If your tuition is not received or if you have not been awarded financial aid by this date, the classes you have registered for will be removed from your schedule. You can re-register for classes on a space-available basis.*
- Homeless Fee Exemption deadline date ..... Dec. 4
- Financial aid awarded date for FAS due date extension for enrollment between Oct. 21 and Dec. 4 ..... Dec. 4
- You can still apply for financial aid after this date; however, you will need to make arrangements for tuition payments while your file is processed.*
- Second due date for Winter Session, Full Term, Weekend College and First 8 Week Session for enrollment between Dec. 5 and Jan. 6 ..... Jan. 6
- If your tuition is not received or if you have not been awarded financial aid by this date, the classes you have registered for will be removed from your schedule. You can re-register for classes on a space-available basis.*
- Financial aid awarded date for FAS due date extension for enrollment between Dec. 5 and Jan. 6 ..... Jan. 6
- You can still apply for financial aid after this date; however, you will need to make arrangements for tuition payments while your file is processed.*
- Residency documentation for tuition purposes submission date ..... Jan. 11
- Select High School and Veteran Out-of-State Waivers ..... Jan. 11
- Due date for Express Session ..... Jan. 29
- Due date for Second 8 Week Session ..... March 5
- FAS due date extension ..... March 25
- This extension is for students who are awarded a financial aid package by Dec. 4 or Jan. 6. If your financial assistance award does not cover the entire balance, you must pay your balance by this date. Students with an extended due date will not be dropped for non-payment by this date. The student may continue in the class, but will be billed for the amount owed. Future registration and official transcripts will not be available until the balance is paid in full.*

## Tuition Payment Plan

- Online enrollment begins ..... Oct. 19
- 0% down payment with 4 monthly payments and \$30 enrollment fee ..... Nov. 15
- 25% down payment with 3 monthly payments and \$35 enrollment fee ..... Dec. 6
- 50% down payment with 2 monthly payments and \$40 enrollment fee ..... Jan. 8
- Last date to increase the payment plan agreement balance ..... Jan. 8
- Last date to decrease or terminate payment plan agreement balance ..... Feb. 9

## Express Tuition Payment Plan

- Online enrollment begins ..... Jan. 18
- 50% down payment with 2 monthly payments and \$40 enrollment fee ..... Feb. 5
- Last date to increase the payment plan agreement balance ..... Feb. 5
- Last date to decrease or terminate payment plan agreement balance ..... March 9

## Book line of credit

- If you will have a remaining balance after tuition and fees are paid, you may use up to \$800 toward books and supplies.*
- Winter Session ..... Dec. 3 – 29
- Begins for all other Spring sessions ..... Dec. 14
- Ends for Full Term, Weekend College and First 8 Week Session ..... Jan. 26
- Ends for enrollment in Express Session only ..... Feb. 23
- Ends for enrollment in Second 8 Week Session only ..... March 30

## Textbook credit

- If you are only enrolled in classes with a later tuition date, you must pay your tuition in full by the date below to be eligible for this credit.*
- \$10 textbook credit ..... Dec. 4
- Last day to use textbook credit ..... March 30

## First and Last day of classes

- Winter Session ..... Dec. 14 – Jan. 8
- Full Term ..... Jan. 11 – May 7
- First 8 Week Session ..... Jan. 11 – March 5
- Weekend College ..... Jan. 15 – May 2
- Express Session ..... Feb. 8 – May 7
- Second 8 Week Session ..... March 15 – May 7

## Last day to drop a class with a refund (drop/add date)

- Winter Session ..... Dec. 15
- Full Term and First 8 Week Session ..... Jan. 15
- Weekend College ..... Jan. 22
- Express Session ..... Feb. 12
- Second 8 Week Session ..... March 19

## Last day to withdraw with a grade of "W"

*Know the consequences of this decision. If you completely withdraw from the college, you will be required to repay financial assistance funds. You must phone the SPC Call Center at 727-791-2485 as you are not able to totally withdraw from all classes through MySPC. DATES ARE SUBJECT TO CHANGE.*

## Non-financial aid refunds

- Winter Session, Full Term, Weekend College and First 8 Week Session ..... Jan. 22
- Express Session ..... Feb. 19
- Second 8 Week Session ..... March 26

## Financial assistance refunds

- Winter Session, Full Term, Weekend College and First 8 Week Session ..... Feb. 5
  - Express Session ..... March 5
  - Second 8 Week Session ..... April 9
- These are projected dates. The Business Office sends refunds by electronic deposit to a BankMobile Vibe Account or your personal bank account. Select your refund preference for BankMobile at [www.spcollege.edu/bankmobile](http://www.spcollege.edu/bankmobile). Students will begin receiving their financial assistance refunds if their financial assistance files are complete and awards are posted.*

## 2020-21 Financial Assistance Benchmarks

- Email** All email notifications are sent to your SPC student email  
*Students may forward their SPC student email to a personal email.*
- Awarding** Financial Assistance awarding occurs DAILY, email notifications are sent DAILY
- Verification** 14 working days from the receipt date of all required documentation  
*Once complete, the verification item(s) will be removed from your MySPC To Do List.*
- SAP Appeals** 15 working days from the receipt date of all required documentation, email notifications are sent DAILY  
*Once a decision is made, the SAP item will be removed from your MySPC To Do List. To check the current SAP status, login to MySPC, select "Financial Aid Status," select the aid year and look in the box in the top right-hand corner.*

Students will be notified by email if, during peak processing times, the benchmarks above have been revised.
