Priority dates

SPC's FAFSA priority deadline date for financial aid packaging May 1
Priority deadline date for admissions applications and materials (i.e. transcripts) for Fall Full Term Aug. 5

You may still enroll in Fall Full Term classes if the application is received after this date; however, there is no guarantee transcripts will be evaluated prior to the beginning of Fall Full Term.

Financial aid awarded date for FAS due date extension July 19

You can still apply for financial aid after this date; however, you will need to make arrangements for tuition payments while your file is processed.

Tuition due dates

Universal due date for Full Term, Weekend College & First 8 Week Session July 19

If your tuition is not received or if you have not been awarded financial aid by this date, the classes you have registered for will be removed from your schedule. You can re-register for classes on a space-available basis, starting 72 hours after being removed from your schedule.

Tuition Payment Plan

Online enrollment begins May 27

0% down payment with 4 monthly payments and \$30 enrollment fee July 5

25% down payment with 3 monthly payments and \$35 enrollment fee Aug. 2

50% down payment with 2 monthly payments and \$40 enrollment fee Aug. 16

Last date to increase the payment plan balance Aug. 16

Last date to decrease or terminate payment plan Sept. 17

Express Session only:

Online enrollment begins Aug. 26

50% down payment with 1 monthly payment and \$40 enrollment fee Sept. 13

Last date to increase the payment plan balance Sept. 13

Last date to decrease or terminate payment plan Oct. 21

Book line of credit

Available at campus bookstores. If you will have a remaining balance after tuition and fees are paid, you may use up to \$800 toward books and supplies.

Begins for all classes July 22

Ends for Fall Full Term, Weekend College and First 8 Week Session Sept. 3

Ends for enrollment in Express Session only Oct. 1

Ends for enrollment in Second 8 Week Session only Oct. 29

Textbook credit

Available at campus bookstores. If you are only enrolled in classes with a later tuition date, you must pay your tuition in full by the date below to be eligible for this credit.

\$10 textbook credit May 27 - July 19

2019-20 Financial Assistance Benchmarks

Email All email notifications are sent to your SPC student email
Students may forward their SPC student email to a personal email.

Awarding Financial Assistance awarding occurs DAILY, email notifications are sent DAILY

Verification 14 working days from the receipt date of all required documentation in the current aid year

Once complete, the verification item(s) will be removed from your MySPC To Do List.

SAP Appeals 15 working days from the receipt date of all required documentation, email notifications are sent DAILY

Once a decision is made, the SAP item will be removed from your MySPC To Do List.

To check the current SAP status, login to MySPC, select "Financial Aid Status," select the aid year and look in the box in the top right-hand corner.

Students will be notified by email if, during peak processing times, the benchmarks above have been revised.

**These are projected dates. The Business Office sends refunds by electronic deposit to a BankMobile Vibe Account or your personal bank account. Select your refund preference for BankMobile at www.spcollege.edu/bankmobile. Students will begin receiving their financial assistance refunds if their financial assistance files are complete and awards are posted. Per Federal regulations, first-time, first-year Stafford borrowers cannot receive their first loan disbursement until 30 calendar days after the first day of classes.*

Due date extension

FAS due date extension Oct. 24

This extension is for students who are awarded a financial aid package on or after July 19. If your financial assistance award does not cover the entire balance, you must pay your balance by this date. Students with an extended due date will not be dropped for non-payment by this date. The student may continue in the class, but will be billed for the amount owed. Future registration and official transcripts will not be available until the balance is paid in full.
