#### Student Internship Checklist

##### **BCN 2949 1-3 credits**

This course is designed to provide students with major-related, supervised, evaluated practical training work experiences which may be paid or voluntary. Students are graded on the basis of documented learning acquired through hands-on experiences in an actual work setting. Variable credits are available, one to three per course. The student must fulfill the requirement of 60 on-the-job hours for each credit earned in addition to written assignments. Internship courses may be repeated but total credits shall not exceed twelve.
