

Associate in Science Degree in Nursing (ASN) options at SPC

SPC offers several options for completing the ASN degree so you can choose the one that best fits your lifestyle:

1. Traditional ASN Track — morning theory schedule

- Four semesters with summer off (2 calendar years)
- Theory courses are in the morning (usually 8am-11am) - 1 day per week + online courses
- Simulations are in the morning (usually 7am-1pm) - 1 day every other week
- Clinical are 1 day per week (M-F, varies) approx. 6am-5pm.
- **Fall and Spring admission**

2. Traditional ASN Track — afternoon theory schedule

- Four consecutive semesters with courses during summer (17 months)
- Theory courses are in the afternoon (usually 1pm-6pm) - 1 day per week + online courses
- Simulations are in the afternoon (usually 1:30 to 7:30pm) – 1 day every other week
- Clinical are 1 day per week (M-F, varies) from approx. 6am – 5pm
- **Fall and Spring admission**

3. Paramedic-ASN Track

- Follow traditional morning theory schedule, other tracks are not available for Paramedic-ASN Track students.

4. Traditional ASN--Evening/weekend ASN track

- Six consecutive semesters with classes during summer (2 years)
- Theory courses are in the evening (usually 5pm-9pm) – 1 day per week + online courses
- Simulations are in the evening (usually 5pm-8pm) – 1 day per week
- Clinicals are 1 day per week on Saturdays from approx. 6am - 5pm
- **Fall admission only**

5. LPN-RN Bridge Track (Day theory schedule with weekday clinical)

This is for students who have completed their LPN at an accredited school and hold a valid LPN license in the State of Florida.

- Three semesters with summer off
- Theory courses are in the afternoon (usually 1pm-6pm) - 1 day per week + online courses
- Simulations are in the afternoon (usually 1:30pm – 7:30pm) - 1 day every other week
- Clinicals are 1 day per week (M-F, varies) from approx. 6am - 5pm
- **Fall admission only.**

6. LPN-RN Bridge Track (Evening classes with weekend clinical)

This is for students who have completed their LPN at an accredited school and hold a valid LPN license in the State of Florida.

- Three semesters with summer off
- Theory courses are in the evening (usually 5pm - 9pm) - 1 day per week + online courses
- Simulations are in the evening (usually 5pm - 8pm) - 1 day every week
- Clinicals are 1 day per week on Saturdays from approx. 6am - 5pm
- **Spring admission only**
