

# Radiography Program Grading System

Below is list of grading scales used by program faculty to determine final grades for didactic and lab courses as well as a description of the method employed to determine final clinical grades.

## **DIDACTIC COURSE GRADING SYSTEM**

The final grade will be computed according to the following scale:

92	to	100	=	A
84	to	91	=	B
75	to	83	=	C
70	to	74	=	D
Below		70	=	F

## **IMAGING I & II LAB GRADING SYSTEM**

The final grade will be computed according to the following scale:

92	to	100	=	A
84	to	91	=	B
75	to	83	=	C
70	to	74	=	D
Below		70	=	F

## **PROCEDURES I & II LAB GRADING SYSTEM**

The simulation portion of this class constitutes 70% of the student's total grade and the final practical examination is worth 30% of the total grade. Grades will be assigned according to the following scale:

93	to	100	=	A
86	to	92	=	B
80	to	85	=	C
75	to	79	=	D
Below		75	=	F

## **CLINICAL GRADING SYSTEM**

The college faculty will assign a clinical grade based on a combination of the following factors:

1. Student achievement of the clinical objectives.
2. Quality and quantity of exams performed.
3. Staff technologist written evaluations.
4. Clinical instructor written evaluation.
5. Observations and/or recommendations of clinical faculty member.
